The conference *Memory, Identity and Narration* is part of the research project *Aesthetics and Therapeia*. Funded by Next Generation EU - MUR/PNRR, the project involves Sapienza - University of Rome, eCampus University, University of Salerno, and University of Catanzaro "Magna Graecia".

The purpose of the conference is to verify the possibility of constructing a theoretical paradigm, integrating two different frameworks: 1) narrative identity theory developed within the hermeneutic-phenomenological school; 2) the psychological theories that highlight a constitutive link between memory, identity, and narration. Therefore, the conference has a constitutive interdisciplinary ambition, aiming to be primarily an occasion for scientific dialogue between philosophers and psychologists.

Among the scholars who have addressed the issue of narrative identity from a philosophical point of view, a prominent place is undoubtedly held by Paul Ricoeur, but the conference does not intend to focus exclusively on his thought. Similarly, within psychological studies, theories of autobiographical memory are particularly relevant for the conference's purposes. Psychological or psychoanalytic approaches, highlighting a structural link between identity and narration, also define areas of research that the conference aims to explore.

Special attention will also be devoted to the practices and theories related to the so-called narrative medicine, considering that the *Aesthetics and Therapeia* project includes an experimental part based on narrative therapy methodologies. This part involves implementing targeted interventions on patients suffering from dementia.
